

How to Bid & Buy

Are you interested in buying antiques, works of art or antique and old carpets? Several times a year our auction house offers high-quality objects.

Bidding

You have several opportunities to take part in our auction as a bidder:

- You can, of course, bid in person during the auction at our house in Cologne-Lindenthal.
- You can submit your **absentee-bids** via our catalog for the respective lot number. To do this, click on the button 'Jetzt Vorgebot abgeben'. A bidding form in pdf format will open, which you can complete and send by fax to 0049 221 44 77 67 or by e-mail to info@auktion-eder.de.
- **Telephone bids** (from a limit of EUR 150) can be submitted in the same way as written pre-bids. Please mark 'telephone' on the bidding form. We will call you at our expense before calling the desired item.
- You can **bid live** via our partner portal **lot-tissimo**. This requires prior registration with lot-tissimo. Click on the 'Live Bieten' button next to the lot number in our catalog and you will be automatically redirected to lot-tissimo. (see at the bottom: new User? Sign up here) After you have registered there, you will receive a confirmation of your auction registration from us.
- You can **also bid live** via our partner portal **Drouot**. This requires also prior registration with Drouot. (www.drouot.com)

Buying

- On the day of the auction, the lot will be knocked down to the highest bidder if no overbid is made after three calls for bids.
- A buyer's premium of 25% incl. VAT will be charged on the winning bid. Please note: The premium for **live bidding via lot-tissimo is 30.95%**. This includes the statutory VAT. The premium for **live bidding via Drouot is 28,57%**. This includes the statutory VAT. You will usually receive your invoice 2 to 3 days after the auction by e-mail or post.
- The buyer has to collect the auctioned items within 7 days. You are also welcome to instruct us to ship the auctioned items via DHL if possible.
